WHY THIS FACILITY MATTERS

For years, Ellsworth County's young wrestlers have trained in borrowed gyms, cramped spaces, and makeshift facilities. A purpose-built home will provide consistent, year-round space for practice, tournaments, camps, and community events.

WHAT WE ARE BUILDING

A standalone wrestling training center on a vacant downtown lot, designed to strengthen youth development, bring families downtown, and serve generations of Ellsworth County wrestlers.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHY IS A FACILITY NEEDED?

Borrowed and shared space limits consistent training. A dedicated home provides reliable, year-round access.

HOW WILL FUNDS BE USED?

Gifts support construction based on current contractor bids totaling \$300,930. Expenditures require board approval.

ARE GIFTS TAX-DEDUCTIBLE?

Yes. ECKWC is a registered 501(c)(3). Gifts are tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law.

WHAT IF THE GOAL IS NOT REACHED?

The board may consider phased construction, bridge financing, or further fundraising. Donors will be informed of significant changes.

HOW ARE GIFTS OVERSEEN?

A volunteer board oversees campaign finances. Funds are held separately, expenditures require authorization, and progress is shared publicly.
